Salvation in the church of the Lord

Lewis Wade Chumbley was my great-great uncle. He was a prominent figure for many years among the saints on Gosser Ridge, Russell Springs, KY. Born in 1865, the year the Civil War ended, he died in 1960. I am printing this article as it appeared, without corrections.

In 1 John 1:7, we are told that "If we walk in the light as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin." In Acts 20:28 it is said that the church of God was purchased with Christs Blood and in John 19:34 we find that Christ shed all the blood that he had, the last that came was water. Now if it took all of Christs blood to purchase salvation for the church, there is none of it left to purchase the salvation of those who are without. This being true, and it is true, then to be saved outside of Christs church would be salvation without the blood of Christ. But in Heb. 9:22, informs us that "without the sheding of blood there is no remission." It is nevertheless a fact that to be saved by the blood of Christ we MUST come into HIS church, which is his body, Eph. 1:22,23, where his blood may be found which cleanseth all sin. Paul in Col. 1:13 says, "Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son." Here we are told that there are just two kingdoms, one Satan's kingdom called the power of darkness, the other Christ's kingdom, or kingdom of his (Gods) dear Son.

Even in the absence of scriptural proof in its favor, the unbiased thinker would see at once that the blessings of Christ's kingdom belong of course to the members of the kingdom. The idea that many of the kingdom of Satan are Christians and sustain the same relation to God respecting salvation as do those of his own kingdom would appear to him as entirely out of the question and very foolish, yet this is just what the religious world teaches today, there is

nothing analogous to it in all the history, or among the people of any Nation. The above language of the inspired apostle teaches directly the opposite. Here we are told that upon being delivered from the power of darkness we ar translated into Christs kingdom in whom (when thus translated of course) we have redemption through his blood even the forgiveness of sins. His kingdom is his church, it is therefore certain that in order to be redeemed by the blood of Christ and have the forgiveness of sins we must be in his kingdom or church.

Finally the members of the church are reprsented as having been married to Christ. 2 Cor. 11:2, "I am jealous over you with godly jealousy, for I have espoused you to one husband that I may present you a chaste virgin to Christ. The church being the bride the Lamb's wife shows you who are to be preferred by the bridegroom when he comes.

The Queen James Bible

A few years ago a Bible translation based off the King James was released which boasts to be the first "Gay Bible" in all the world.

Titled the Queen James Bible, its publishers argue that this translation accurately translates certain verses pertaining to homosexuality, which have been misunderstood by religious conservatives for centuries.

According to the publishers, "Homosexuality was first overtly mentioned in the Bible in 1946 in the Revised Standard Version. There is no mention of or reference to homosexuality in any Bible prior to this – only interpretations have been made. The Queen James Bible addresses those controversial verses by editing them very slightly for interpretive clarity. The edits all confirm that the Bible does not condemn homosexuality, and therefore renders such interpretations impossible."

Douglas J. Moo, Wessner Chair of Biblical Studies at Wheaton College, told The Christian Post that the Queen James editors' assessment of past bible translations is not entirely accurate. He said, "Few, if any English translations use the actual words 'homosexuality' or 'homosexual.' But the history of English translation shows that versions have consistently used other language to refer to what we would call homosexual

relationships."

Moo writes, "For instance, the King James Version of Romans 1:27 refers to 'men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly.' It would be very difficult to deny that this language, and the language found in many other places in both the OT and the NT, refers to homosexuality."

The Queen James has a mysterious background. On its official website, no specific publisher, editors or publishers are named. On Amazon.com, the author is listed as God and the contributor as Jesus Christ.

Don't be mistaken, this is all about trying to convince religious people that homosexuality is not a sin and thus same sex marriage is acceptable to God. So, they attempt to change passages such as Gen 19 1.11; Lev 18.22, 20.13; Rom 1.18-32; 1 Cor 6.9-11 which all speak about the sin of homosexuality into something else.
